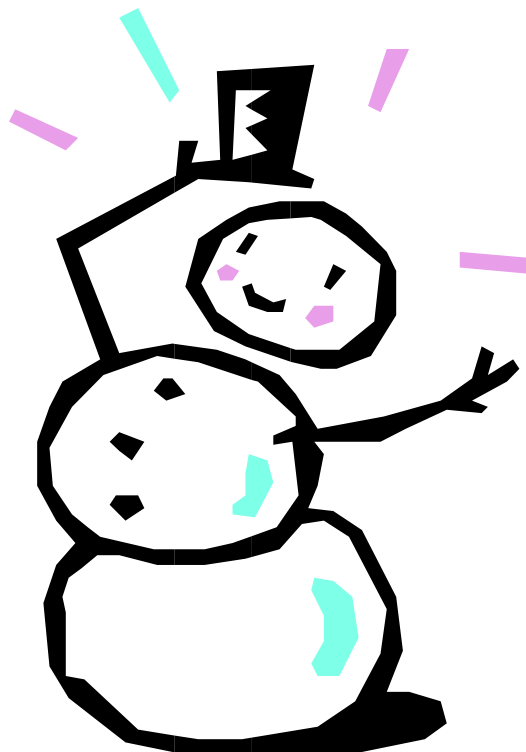

GENERAL INFORMATION

Program Refund Policy

Refunds will be given if the activity is cancelled by SRS or if the participant is experiencing medical complications. To receive the refund the SRS office must be notified before the scheduled event. Some SRS programs may be cancelled due to adverse weather conditions, some may be rescheduled as time allows. After rescheduling, if the participant can not make the program due to schedule conflict they will be refunded for that portion of the program. Once a program has begun, no refunds will be given.

Program Cancellation

A program may be cancelled if the enrollment consists of less than the minimum participants. If a program is cancelled, you will be notified and given the option of being credited.

Americans with Disabilities Act

Special Recreation Services supports the Americans with Disabilities Act. SRS will provide all reasonable accommodations to include persons with disabilities in the community. It is the belief of SRS that all people are created equal and that they should have equal rights to recreation and leisure opportunities.

Inclusion

SRS advocates for all participants who wish to be provided with recreation and leisure opportunities in their own community. We support programs that allow the participants to perform at the highest possible ability level with success. Some participants may choose traditional SRS programs, while other's may choose park district offered programs. In cooperation with park district staff, SRS will help to provide reasonable accommodations for all persons interested in inclusion in park district programs. Contact SRS for additional information.

OUT-OF-DISTRICT POLICY

SRS will accept out-of-district participants into our programs with their registration and payment of the \$1,200 annual maintenance fee. This fee can be paid them to in installments, through your own park district or at once. To pay in installments you must make arrangements with the SRS Director. 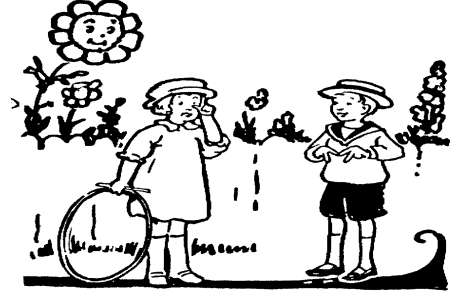

Late Pick Up Policy

SRS reserves the right to administer a fee for late pick up. All children must be picked up by 3:00 PM or 6:00 PM unless otherwise arranged with Erica. A fee of \$1 per minute will be charged after the initial 10 minutes. If the parent/guardian is more than 30 minutes late after the program ends and has made no attempt to contact the SRS staff, the police will be called and a report of abandonment will be made.

Repeat offenses will report in the child being expelled from the program.

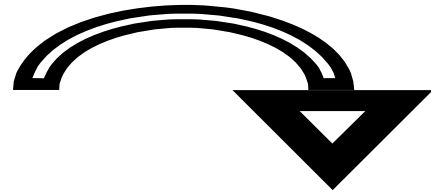
